Wayne County Health Department REQUIREMENTS FOR A TEMPORARY PARK-CAMP

"Temporary park-camp" means any tract of land used for a period not to exceed a total of twenty-one days per calendar year for the purpose of parking five or more recreational vehicles, dependent recreational vehicles, or portable camping units, or any combination thereof, for one or more periods of time that do not exceed seven consecutive days or parts thereof. Please maintain a safe and healthy campground.

—OAC 3701-25-51

Density

- ✓ Each unit must maintain at least 15 feet between the sides of the unit and any building, street, public roadway, and right of way.
- ✓ Each unit must maintain at least 10 feet between the ends of the units.
- ✓ Each unit must maintain at least 7 ½ feet from any property line.
- ✓ Each lot must maintain unobstructed travel between/to units. This includes popouts. Obstructed travel will not be tolerated.

(In computing distance requirements, awnings are not included, but pop out rooms are.)

Local fire authorities may require distances greater than those stated above. These are minimum requirements

Fire Extinguishers

✓ Each unit is recommended to have a working, properly tested and available fire extinguisher. Please note for the 2012 Wayne County Fair this will be a requirement.

Sites

Sites must be properly drained and kept free of trash and debris. No trash shall be directly on the ground but in closed garbage receptacles. Please clean up your animal waste.

Water Supply

- ✓ The primary water source must be protected from contamination by a backflow prevention device rated ASSE 1024 or 1012.
- ✓ Each hose connection must also have an ASSE 1024 backflow prevention device.
- ✓ All water hoses must be rated for potable water use only.

Sewage and Liquid Waste

All sites must be maintained free of sewage and liquid waste nuisances. The sewage collection/waste water disposal facility shall be maintained in a safe and sanitary manner so as not to create a health hazard. Use the dump stations!!! Do not dispose of sewage or grey water on the lot. This will not be tolerated.

Solid Waste Storage and Collection


Storage and collection of solid waste must be conducted to avoid health hazards.

Electrical Service

Electrical services must be in compliance with any applicable state and local electrical codes.
