

## **REGULATION # 135**

### **A REGULATION ESTABLISHING AND REVISING PERMIT FEES, LICENSE FEES AND SERVICE FEES IN THE WAYNE COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT.**

A regulation establishing and revising permit, license and service fees charged to provide for payment toward costs of providing sanitary services and inspections, and to declare an emergency.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Health of the Wayne County General Health District as follows:

#### Section 1 ( Annual Fees )

The annual fee for registration, licenses, permits and/or service charges are:

- (a) Registration of private sewage system installers:  
Renewable annually on or before December 31 - one hundred (100) dollars.
- (b) Registration of plumbers: Renewable annually on or before December 31 – one hundred (100) dollars.
- (c) Scavenger and Garbage Collectors: Renewable annually on or before December 31 -
  - (1) Sewage Tank and Privy Cleaners - sixty (60) dollars per vehicle.
  - (2) Offal and Dead Animal Haulers - sixty (60) dollars per vehicle.
  - (3) Garbage Collectors and Haulers - Two hundred (200) dollars plus fifty (50) dollars per vehicle in excess of two (2).
- (d) Solid Waste Disposal Sites or Facilities: Renewable annually on or before December 31
  - (1) Solid Wastes Disposal Facility - Determined by Section 3734.06 (A)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code.
  - (2) Solid Waste Transfer Station - Determined by Section 3734.01 (U) of the Ohio Revised Code.
- (e) Registration of Sludge Haulers: Renewable annually on or before December 31 - two hundred (200) dollars.
- (f) Septage Disposal Farms: Renewable annually on or before December 31 - one hundred (100) dollars per farm.

**APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER DECEMBER 31 WILL BE SUBJECT TO 100% PENALTY**

## Section 2 (State Licenses)

Annual licenses and inspection fees established by Ohio Revised Code and/or Ohio Sanitary Code of the State of Ohio shall apply to Recreational Vehicle Parks, Recreation Camps, Combined Park-Camps, Food Service, Vending and Manufactured Mobile Home Parks.

## Section 3 (Private Water Systems)

The fees for private water systems as defined by Section 3701.344 of the Ohio Revised Code shall be as follows:

- (A) A permit for the installation of a new private water system for a single family dwelling - one hundred and fifty (150) dollars.
- (B) A permit for the installation of a new private water system for a non-single family dwelling - one hundred and sixty (160) dollars.
- (C) A permit for the alteration of a private water system for a single family dwelling - seventy-five (75) dollars.
- (D) A permit for the alteration of a private water system for a non-single family dwelling – eighty (80) dollars.
- (E) For a water hauler vehicle inspection conducted under Section 3701-28-18 (C) of the Ohio Administrative Code - ten (10) dollars
- (F) Additional amount to be added to the applicable fees established under subsections (A), (B), (C), and (D) of this section when the Board of Health determines that installation or alteration of a private water system has commenced prior to a permit being issued - 100% of the applicable fee.

This additional fee shall not be charged for an emergency alteration performed in compliance with Section 3701-28-03 (B) (1) of the Ohio Administrative Code.

- (G) Water sample for bacteriological analysis - twenty (20) dollars.
- (H) For the collection and bacteriological examination of water samples taken from private water systems installed or altered under permits established under subsection (A), (B), (C) and (D) of this section shall be done for no additional fee for the first two (2) samples taken within one (1) year of the permit issuance date.

## Section 4 (Private Sewage Disposal Systems)

- (A) A permit for the installation of a new private sewage disposal system - one hundred and fifty (150) dollars.
- (B) Extension of a new private sewage disposal permit for a period not to exceed one year - twenty five (25) dollars if paid within thirty (30) days after the expiration date of the original permit and provided that the conditions surrounding the issuance of the original permit remain the same.
- (C) A permit for the alteration of a private sewage disposal system -fifty (50) dollars
- (D) A permit for the reinspection of a private sewage disposal system - thirty five (35) dollars
- (E) An operational permit for off-lot disposal systems and experimental systems - twenty five (25) dollars.

- (F) Additional amount to be added to the applicable fees established under subsections (A) and (C) of this section when the Board of Health determines that installation or alteration of a private sewage disposal system has commenced prior to a permit being issued - 100% of the applicable fee.

**Section 5 (Plumbing Permit and Plumbing Inspection Fees)**

(A) Base Fee - Residential	\$35.00
(B) Base Fee - Commercial/Industrial	\$75.00
(C) Fixture Fee (per fixture)	\$04.00
(D) Partial Inspection or Re-Inspection Fee	\$35.00

**A PENALTY OF 100% OF THE ORIGINAL PERMIT FEE MAY BE ASSESSED FOR ANY WORK STARTED PRIOR TO ISSUANCE OF PROPER PERMITS OR APPROVALS.**

**Section 6 (Land Splits)**

At the time of submitting a preliminary plan the subdivider shall pay a processing fee of fifty ( 50 ) dollars per lot.

**Section 7 (Sludge Farms)**

A one-time fee of one hundred and fifty (150) dollars plus fifty cents (.50) per acre in excess of one hundred (100) acres per site shall be paid upon submission of the application. Said fee shall be used to cover the costs of reviewing said application. An inspection fee of fifteen cents (.15) per one hundred (100) gallons shall be required for any sludge applied to land in Wayne County. Said fee must be submitted by the sixteenth of the month following the month for which this charge is made.

**Section 8 (Manufactured Home Parks)**

The annual license fee for a manufactured home park as defined in Section 3733.01 of the Ohio Revised Code shall be based on the number of lots in the park as follows:

<u>NUMBER OF LOTS</u>	<u>LICENSE FEE</u>
First Fifty Lots	\$200.00
Additional Amount For Each Individual Lot In Excess of Fifty	\$ 3.00

**Section 9 (Recreational Vehicle Park Camps, Recreation Camps & Combined Park Camps)**

The annual license fee for a recreational vehicle park camp, recreation camp and combined park camp as defined in Section 3733.01 of the Ohio Revised Code shall be based on the number of lots in the camp as follows:

<u>Number of Lots</u>	<u>License Fee</u>
First Fifty Lots	\$150.00
Each individual lot in Excess of Fifty	\$ 1.50

Section 10 (Resident Camps)

The annual license fee for a resident camp shall be fifty (50) dollars per year.

Section 11 (Public Swimming Pools, Public Spas, Special Pools)

The annual license fee for public swimming pools, public spas, and special use pools as defined in Section 3749.01 of the Ohio Revised Code shall be as follows:

Individual Public Swimming Pool	\$250.00
Individual Public Spa	\$250.00
Individual Special Use Pool	\$250.00

Although each public swimming pool, public spa, or special use pool must be issued an individual license, when a public swimming pool, public spa, or special use pool which has been assessed a fee pursuant to this section is located at the same address as additional public swimming pools, public spas, or special use pools, the license fee for each of those additional public swimming pools, public spas, or special use pools shall be one hundred and twenty five (125) dollars.

Section 12 (Food Service Operations)

The annual license fee for food service operations, vending food service operations, mobile food service operations and temporary food service operations as defined in Section 3732 of the Ohio Revised Code shall be as follows:

Section 13 (Load Approval Inspection/Report)

Water System (Includes one sample)	\$ 20.00
Sewage System	\$ 50.00
Water & Sewage Systems	\$100.00

Section 14 (Variance Requests)

At the time of submitting a request for a variance to regulations of the Wayne County General Health District, the request shall be accompanied by a fee of one hundred (100) dollars. A variance renewal request shall be accompanied by a fee of fifty (50) dollars.

Section 15 (Repeal.)

Existing sanitary regulations, and sections or paragraphs or regulations of the Board of Health of the Wayne County Combined General Health District in conflict or inconsistent with this regulation are hereby repealed.

Section 16 (Penalty)

Any person who violates any provision of this regulation shall be in violation of, and subject to the penalties in Section 3709.99 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 17 (Effect of Partial Invalidity)

Should any provision of this regulation be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remainder of this regulation shall not be affected thereby.

Section 18 (Effective Date)

This regulation shall be effective on and after the first day of January, 1995.
